Impact

The impact on the whole school is as follows:

- Increased enjoyment in sports.

- Better sportsmanship and social skills.
- Developing a greater understanding of sports.
- Understanding more complex instructions in a range of sporting contexts.
- Increased desire to participate in PE activities during playtimes eg skipping , basketball, hula hooping

Next steps

The specialist sports and football coaches have been retained for the coming year to deliver consistently high quality PE progression throughout the whole school.

To achieve the Silver Level in the School Games Mark.

Enter a wider range of competitive sporting competitions internally and externally.

Generated and distribute a pupil questionnaire to evaluate areas of interest and motivation for children. This will be used to inform the club provision for the coming year.

Look at sustainability of our PE provision in the 2016/2017 budget and subsequent years.

Look at ways of increasing income into the school through lettings and fundraising to ensure PE provision is sustainable.

Investigate further lunchtime clubs to include Paralympic sports.
