THE HOW WOOD CODE OF CONDUCT:

- See that my child goes to school regularly, on time.
- Ring the Office before 9am to tell them if my child will be absent.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure my child is wearing the correct school uniform.
- Support my child in homework.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and bullying (policies available on request).
- Attend parents' evenings.
- Avoid taking my child out of school in term-time.
