

# How Wood Primary School Home School Agreement



## The How Wood Code of Conduct:

- We will always show respect to everyone.
- We will be polite and helpful.
- We will be truthful.
- We will always call people by their proper names.
- We will care for our belongings, our classrooms and the whole school.
- When we play, we will let others join our games, share our toys and be friendly with each other.
- We expect everyone to walk around the school sensibly and safely.
- We expect everyone to understand what is the right way to behave and what is not, to be prepared to take responsibility for our actions and understand that inappropriate behaviour will be firmly dealt with.

## The School will:

- Send home and mark homework regularly (Homework policy available).
- Arrange parents' consultation evenings and send home an annual report informing parents about their child's progress.
- Keep parents informed about school activities through newsletters or letters.
- Let parents know if there are concerns about their child's behaviour or learning.
- Expect parents to take full responsibility if their child accesses age-inappropriate internet technologies outside of school.

## The Parents/Carers will:

- Ensure that my child gets to school regularly and punctually.
- Ring the Office before 9am to tell them if my child will be absent.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's learning or behaviour.
- Ensure my child is wearing the correct school uniform (see prospectus and school website)
- Support my child in homework.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and bullying (Policies available).
- Attend parents' evenings.
- Avoid taking my child out of school in term-time unless in exceptional circumstances (Attendance Policy available)
- Abide by the school's policies and guidelines regarding e-safety and not allow my child to have access to age-inappropriate internet technologies including: Websites; apps; instant messaging; chat rooms; social media, including Instagram, Facebook & Twitter. (e-Safety & Acceptable Use Policy)
- Take full responsibility if my child accesses age-inappropriate internet technologies outside of school.

## The Pupil will:

- Be polite and helpful.
- Do my homework.
- Always do my best.
- Come to school on time every day.
- Behave respectfully and safely in the playground.
